Title:	Trinket Box
Date:	1880 – 1920
Material:	stone, serpentine; wood, teak
Dimensions:	13.0 x 9.5 x 15.0 cm
Description:	An urn-shaped serpentine bowl with heavy dragon-shaped handles (serpentine is a mottled green or yellow hydrous magnesium silicate, used as source of asbestos and as architecturally decorative stonework). The teak lid is bell-shaped and features intricately carved openwork. There is slight wear on inside bottom of bowl, and the top is slightly damaged.

Description:	A lathe-turned round-dish, flat-bottomed box with a domed, lapping lid which fits flushly over a flange on the box body. Box and lid are painted a boxcar red and decorated with designs of circles and flowers, varnish over paint has oxidized. Interior of box has been painted a dark green.

Title:	Trinket Box
Date:	1950 – 1955
Material:	foot, deer; hair, deer; wood; skin; antler, deer
Dimensions:	20.0 x 27.0 x 27.0 cm
Description:	A round cylindrical box which is supported by the feet of deer which have their hair and hooves left on. The four hooves have been split behind the shaft and the fetlocks have been drawn to one side, so that the cylinder is completely covered. The compartment is leather lined and edged. Sitting on and in the box is the varnished wood lid which has a handle made of deer antler, also varnished. Inside is a letter that reads "Hello Everybody, Just a little present., From Bill. And my partner Harold King. - B. Lagarde" along with two pieces of bone; a crystal; and a perfectly round stone.

Description:	Oblong rectangular lidded box with wood base and copper lid. Box base lightweight wood and remnant of Canada One Cent stamp stuck on bottom. Lid decoration has circle symmetrically decorated with pierced scrolling. Lid separated from rim by copper corrosion.
