Material: stone, serpentine; wood, teak

Dimensions: 13.0 x 9.5 x 15.0 cm

Description: An urn-shaped serpentine bowl with heavy dragon-shaped handles

(serpentine is a mottled green or yellow hydrous magnesium silicate, used as scurce of asbestos and as architecturally decorative stonework). The teak lid is bell-shaped and features intricately carved openwork. There is slight wear on inside bottom of bowl, and the top is slightly

damaged.

Dimensions: 6.3 x 13.0 cm

Description: A lathe-turned round-dish, flat-bottomed box with a domed, lapping lid

which fits flushly over a flange on the box body. Box and lid are painted a boxcar red and decorated with designs of circles and flowers, varnish over paint has oxidized. Interior of box has been painted a dark green.

Description: Two oval, lidded, birchbark baskets with flat bases, straight sides. (A)

White crosshatch and red zig-zag quillwork on exterior with black thread trim at rim and base (where sweetgrass is located, red and white flower design on lid, as well as sweetgrass. Black thread rim trim. (B) green and white "X" design in quillwork on exterior, with sweetgrass and black thread trim at rim and base. Red flower with green and white stem on lid in quillwork, as well as sweetgrass black thread rim trim. "Quest" sticker

(Banff store) on base.

unvarnished on bottom. "Made in U.S.S.R." sticker on bottom. Decoration is stained yellow and red straw or grass arranged in floral and geometric

diamond design throughout lid and sides.

Material: metal; wood

Dimensions: 3.5 x 4.2 x 17.8 cm

Description: Oblong rectangular lidded box with wood base and copper lid. Box base

lightweight wood and remnant of Canada One Cent stamp stuck on bottom. Lid decoration has circle symmetrically decorated with pierced

scrolling. Lid separated from rim by copper corrosion.
