Date:	1890 – 1910
Material:	metal; skin; fibre
Dimensions:	24.0 x 1.0 x 14.5 cm
Description:	A brown suede purse which hangs by two straps from a fabric belt. There is a small money holder with a metal frame that fits inside a pocket. The money holder fastens with two snaps. The lining of the purse is stamped with a patent note.

Title:	Purse
Date:	1965 – 1970
Material:	skin; fibre
Dimensions:	25.0 x 8.5 x 30.0 cm
Description:	A grey leather, commercially tanned, handmade purse, distinguished by a pocket in the front which contains two small papoose figures with hand painted faces. The purse has two parallel flaps which flop over the top and tie, and a very long pair of shoulder straps. Part of the sewing is cotton, part of it is sinew. The bag contains a piece of sinew.

Title:	Purse
Date:	1900 – 1930
Material:	fibre
Dimensions:	24.3 x 16.5 cm
Description:	A rectangular bag of ecru linen with drawstring top and flower basket embroidered one side, lion rampant on other. Short fringe at bottom from linen threads with coloured threads introduced. Drawn and tied threads along top form slits through which a heavy, beige, silk cord drawstring is threaded. Two loop handles of same cord attached on inside. Lined with wine coloured silk. Flower basket and lion very delicately worked in cross stitch using linen as a canvas. Colours in bottom fringe pick up colours in embroidery and are different on each side of bag.

Title:	Purse
Date:	1900 – 1930
Material:	fibre
Dimensions:	25.0 x 25.2 cm
Description:	A flat, square drawstring bag of green wallpaper patterned silk with varied, patterned vertical strips of mustard yellow accented with black lines. Small loops of buttonhole stitched thread passing around the bag below the mouth hold a light green ribbon drawstring knotted together at the ends. Lined with ivory coloured silk, with the ends of the green thread loops knotted through on the inside.

Dimensions:	15.0 x 20.0 cm
Description:	Lady's black silk, floral embroidery, fold over, red lining, one flap pocket and 3 slot pockets, folded over 15.0 x 10.0, front has embroidered 7 rose coloured flowers with brown and green stems and leaves, back has 2 white coloured flowers with 2 shades of green for stems and leaves.
