

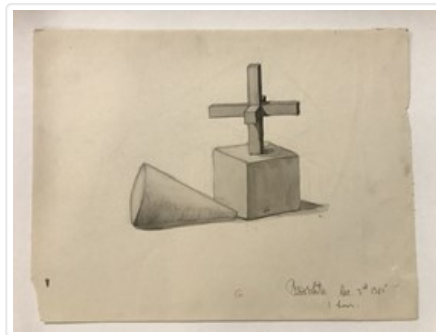

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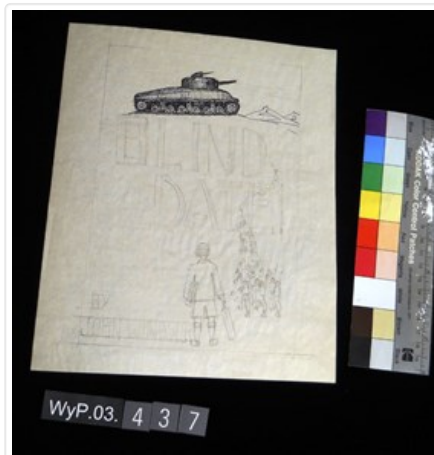

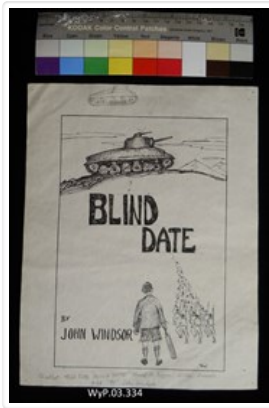

Description:

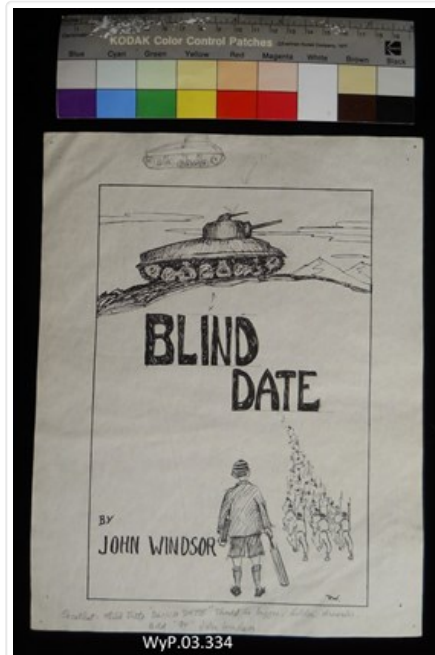

Description:

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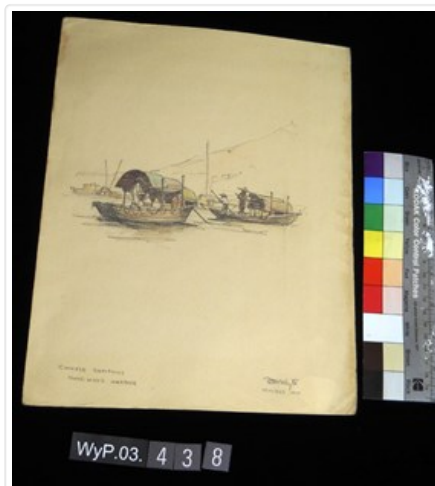


Chinese Sampan, Hong Kong Harbour

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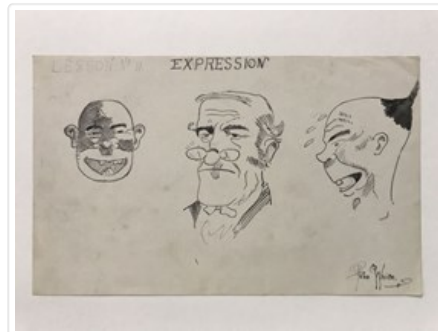

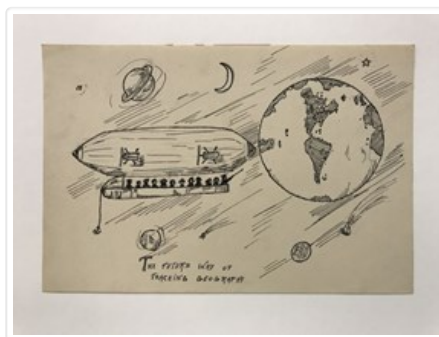

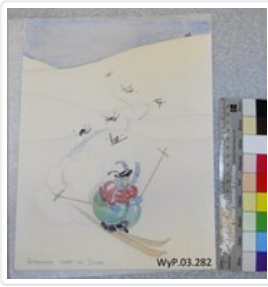

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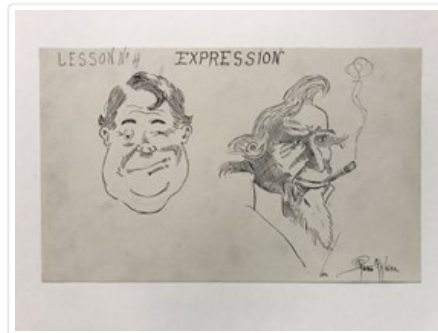
