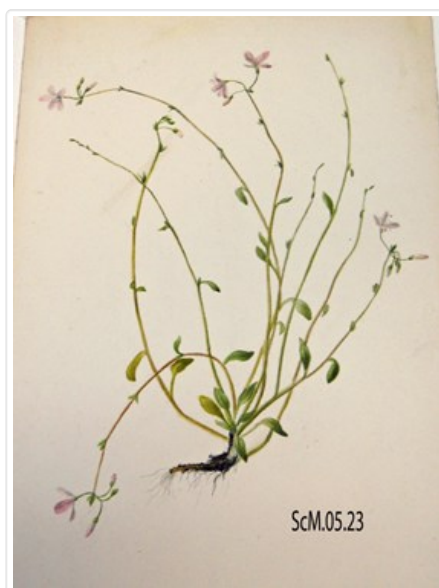


## Montia (Claytonia) parvifolia (Small-leaved Springbeauty)
