Description:	Transparent porcelain teapot with cobalt slip near base. Gold lustre and pink enamel over glaze, signed inside lid. Hollow handle, straining holes inside spout. Has been cracked and repair can be seen on inside. Cobalt in dragon design, gold lustre and pink flowers, red and gold butterfly.

Title:	Teapot

Description:	Dark brown fired clay with white black green enamel over glazes. Square shape to teapot with two side panels containing enamel crane scenes. Lid and pot handle in form of pine trees and added separately. Pot is press molded. Signature stamp to left of pot handle. Tree root close to signature stamp chipped. Steam hole in lid concealed in tree trunk. Finger prints /marks form a pattern.

Description:	<p>Dark brown fired clay with pink green white black over glaze enamels. Two panels, one containing feather and other containing pink camellia flower. Spout in form of applied raccoon decoration with tail protruding from opposite side of pot. Two applied loops for attachment to possibly a bamboo handle, lid knob swivels, two steam holes in lid. Serrated ridge near base. Signature stamp near raccoon tail. Folklore "Bunbuku Chagama". A raccoon who turned into a cast iron tea kettle. Finger prints form pattern on the bottom.</p>

Description:	Gray, green, white glazes. Handle and spout applied separately, grill work handle. Hand thrown body and slab built base attached to each other, then tool trimmed at base, fine strainer inside pot. Teapot lid swivels. Porcelain slip drawing of a Dragon and a cloud on the body, a Dragon on the lid.

Title:	Teapot
Date:	1850 – 1900
Material:	ceramic
Dimensions:	6.4 x 8.2 x 9.8 cm
Description:	Transparent glaze with blue, green, red, gold metal enamel over glazes. Inside pot rim 1.5 cm. chipped off. Fragments seen in glaze inside of pot. Was thrown initially and later hand formed and tool trimmed to create shape. One handle has been repaired once before because of glaze traces. Whyte Estate staff re-glued handle to pot March, 1980 with alpha cyanoecrylate ("Crazy Glue").

Title:	Teapot
Date:	1870 – 1935
Material:	ceramic
Dimensions:	6.6 x 7.8 x 9.4 cm
Description:	Shallow straight sided, almost flat topped tea pot. Hand thrown with attached spout and roughly tooled base. Lid was dipped in a grey slip then the top of the lid was decorated by brushwork with glazes to create dark green colour. Lid handle attached separately. Teapot was dipped in a beige salmon slip then glaze brush applied, creating dark green and rust colours.

Description:	Finely crafted factory piece. Celadon glaze with mishima, inlaid white slip, borders on pot and lid, fine crackling in glaze, chip out of handle .7 x .4 cm. size. Lid has tiny vapour hole. Spout and handle attached separately, handle having decorative cooling and drainage holes and is hollow. Stamp below handle. Very fine strainer inside teapot.
