Title:	Potato Masher
Date:	1950 – 1960

Dimensions:	11.3 x 8.7 x 25.5 cm
Description:	<p>Black and silver metal hand-held plunger-style potato masher. The lower section of the handle wraps around the round silver basket, which is completely covered in small round holes - the upper section attaches to the round solid metal plunger plate that can move slightly to accommodate moving in and out of the basket on the hinged handle. The manufacturer details are engraved on the top of the solid metal plunger plate.</p>

Dimensions:	6.9 cm
Description:	<p>Cream and red cylindrical thread holder with a small head with a black painted face and red hat on top. Inside the main body is a cream-coloured insert with three different coloured threads wrapped around it, separated by disks - the insert has a hollow opening at the top where three sewing needles [one of which has a short length of black thread in it] are housed. "FRENCH IVORY" is stamped on the bottom.</p>

Reflectors Flash

Title:	Reflectors Flash
Date:	1950 – 1975
Material:	metal; plastic;
Dimensions:	15.2 x 15.2 x 12.1 cm
Description:	Three cone-shaped flash reflector attachments of different configurations. The largest reflector has a matte black metal mount with "HR" inscribed inside a circle on both sides - the reflector is perpendicular to the base of the mount and directly opposite from the base of the cone is a red plastic button. The plug for the light bulb is located in the middle of the cone. The mid-sized reflector consists of a bowl-shaped disk with a bulb plug at the bottom and a matte black metal mount directly below that. In the middle of the reflector is a small dent. The smallest reflector is a deep cone-shape with a central plug for the light bulb and another plug for the reflector on the outside.
