Biographical:

Marshall Diverty served as president of the Trail Riders of the Canadian Rockies in 1943.

Scope & Content:

File consists of one photograph album with images pertaining to Marshall Diverty, his daughter Jane Diverty (MacFarland) and other members of the Trail Riders of the Canadian Rockies participating in trail rides and related events, ca.1940-1945.

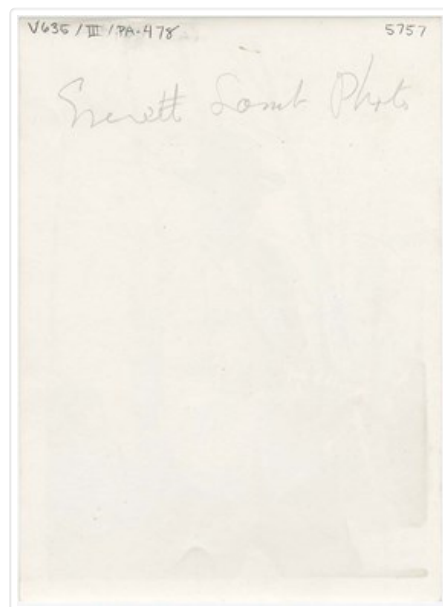

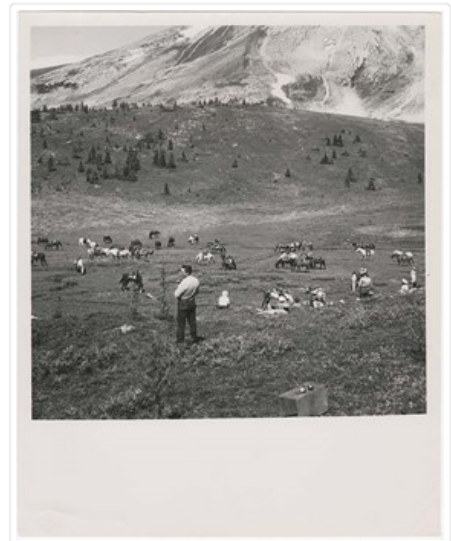
