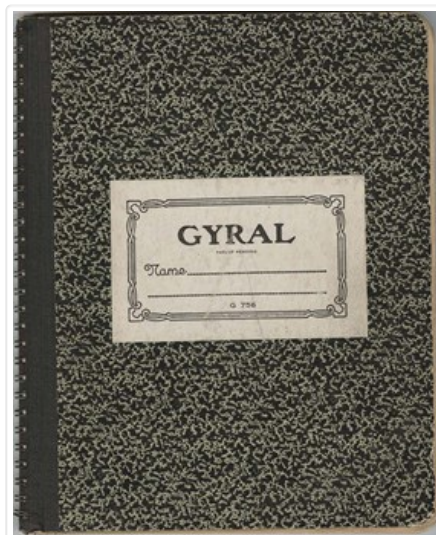

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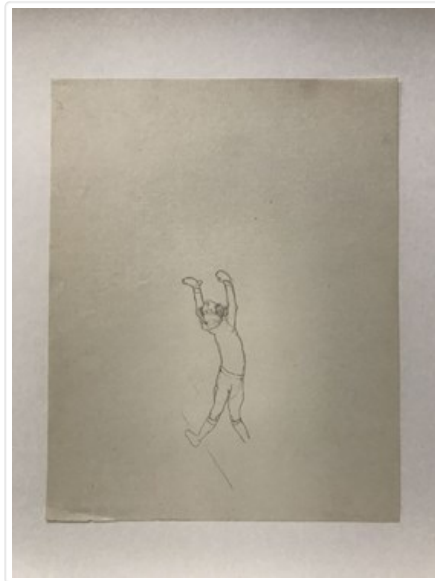

Inside the fold of the paper you can see a simple sketch of the floor plan of their cabin (main level), and inside one room it reads "kitchen." 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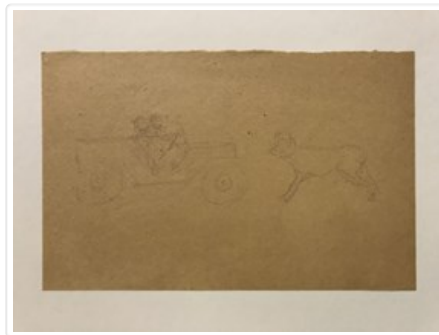
