Title: Basketry Vase
Date: 1877 – 1883
Material: wood; fibre; paper
Dimensions: 11.0 x 5.0 cm

Description: A small sac-shaped flower holder of brown wickerwork with open mouth

at top finished with braided rim. Three-leaved vine attached to side of mouth is of leaf fibre backed with newspaper on shaped frame with coiled vine stem. Small loop on opposite side of mouth. Bamboo tube for

holding water is missing.
