Title:	Flower Bowl
Date:	1800 – 1900
Material:	ceramic, porcelain
Dimensions:	2.4 x 4.8 cm
Description:	Small lens-shaped bowl with circular opening at top. Totally glazed in cobalt, trimmed foot, thickening of cobalt in places. Design cast to resemble petal rays and sections, shape imbalanced. Note in jar reads "Hashidate ware small jar - produced at Ama-no-Hashidate in Tango province" *note is in 3 pieces).
