

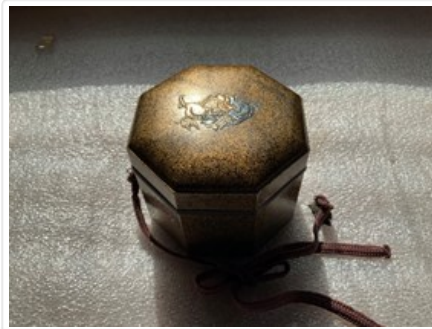


### Trinket Box

Title:	Trinket Box
Date:	1870 – 1890
Material:	metal; wood; fibre
Dimensions:	9.6 x 11.6 x 12.5 cm
Description:	Octagonal, lidded box with inset tray resting on same rim as lid rests on. Flat base and straight walls which are gold/black speckled lacquer. On lid: 2 Chinese lions, one white, one black - playfully fighting, underside of lid and tray, they are resting, in base peony, handles also peony in brass. Mauve cord passes through handles.
