Description: A woman's cape of black silk bordered extensively with netted jet bads

and fringe. The silk is shoulder width at the top and narrows down to points hanging below the waist. The cape is a small size and very heavy in weight. The cape has a high collar that closes with hooks, and the

bodice also fastens with hooks at the front.
