Material: fibre; glass
Dimensions: 7.2 x 73.2 cm

Description: A wide heavily beaded cotton backed belt. Beadwork pattern is a dark

green ground, bilateral symmetrical forms of red diamonds with white borders, and staircases of yellow, white and red forms. Cotton backing

has been machine stitched to the heavier bead base.
