Description: White beaded background with 5 geometric designs, white pony beads

stitched through canvas, 3 similar designs ca 17.0 x 7.0 diamond

shapes, all outlined with dark blue, 2 outer designs with yellow, light blue and orange, centre design with dark blue, light blue and orange, 2 smaller diamond and square designs separate the 3 outlined in dark blue, with light blue and orange centres, buckskin ends sewn on with 2 thongs each

end, ca 21.0 long.
