Description: A rectangular flat bag of moosehide with a long moosehide fringe and a

handle formed from two strips of moosehide tied together. The front of the bag is entirely beaded, with a background of turquoise patterned with red diagonal stripes in a row along each side and a column of red pyramids

up the centre.
