Title: Beaded Bag
Date: 1890 – 1910
Material: skin; fibre; glass
Dimensions: 12.5 x 32.0 cm

Description: A flat rectangular purse with a long fringe along the bottom edge. The

bag's opening fastens with a thong which ties through two holes. The front of the purse is defined with an outline of beads, the inside of which is filled with vertical rows of beads forming a horizontal design of three

diamonds at the top and at the bottom.
