Material: skin; fibre; metal
Dimensions: 31.5 x 13.7 cm

Description: Small rectangular bag with long shoulder strap, embroidered, machine

sewn. Front, back and flap one piece, 2 sewn-in gussets. Long 56.5x 2.0 shoulder strap. Lined with pink floral material, single snap closure. Embroidered design on front and flap. Front motif is a purple flower with orange centre, one pink bud, 2 green leaves, dark brown stems. On flap

single 5-leaved red flower, one green leaf, brown stem.
