Description: Soft white buckskin drawstring bag with fringe along bottom. Thong

drawstring strung through slits in bag and ends knotted together. Top edge of bag has a row of orange and blue beads. Beaded pattern on one side (24.0x 19.5 cm) white background with diamond shape of small multicoloured blocks of light blue, orange, dark blue, red, yellow and

green with large white diamond in middle.
