## Academic Gown

Title: Academic Gown
Date: 1902 – 1902
Material: fibre, cotton
Dimensions: 130.0 cm

Description: A long black academic gown with long wide pointed sleeves gathered at

the shoulders. The gown opens down the length of the gown front, with a wide panel on either side, and snaps to fasten at the top creating a V-neck. The back of the gown is gathered between the shoulders with a square 'collar' at the yoke and a line of twisted cording down centre that buttons at the bottom of the yoke. The monogram "P.A.M." is sewn on a label at the neck. There is also a manufacturer's label at the neck.
