Title:	Tea Jar

Material:	ceramic; ivory
Dimensions:	7.6 x 5.2 cm
Description:	Hand-thrown, container with wire-cut, shell-imitation flat foot; shape of container is similar to urn with soft, rounded shoulders; lid missing knob, foil liner and very fine concentric circles incised around knob hole; illegible writing on base... "NY"?; temmoku glaze which is fairly consistent brown colour; rim has black and green accents. katatsuki: Shouldered shape.
