Title:	Thermometer
Date:	1890 – 1925
Material:	wood; glass; metal, brass; metal, mercury
Dimensions:	1.6 x 2.9 x 13.5 cm
Description:	<p>A field thermometer in a long narrow wooden box case with a brass ring at the top for hanging, and a small brass latch hook to secure the thermometer which slides into the box forming the lid when closed in place. The sliding piece can be reversed to display a glass tube mercury-filled thermometer attached to a brass plaque scaled from 100 to 1200 (Fahrenheit). The inside of the case is marked "183" in pencil and there is a brass plaque on the box labelled "Charles Wilder Co. N.Y." and "Williams, Brown and Earle Phila".</p>
