Title: Sampler

Date: 1794 – 1796

Material: fibre, flax; wood; paper; metal

Dimensions: 19.0; 21.0 (frame) x 13.5; 16.0 (frame) cm

Description: A needlepoint sampler, in many colours, done in cross-stitch on ecru

linen. The sampler has a narrow stitched border with a design in the band at the top followed by rows of letters separated by horizontal bars. The alphabet is stitched with each letter worked twice, followed by the alphabet with each letter worked once until "P" at the end of the sampler where "Susana Lhaman" (sic) is stitched. The sampler was originally framed with a simple brown wood frame with parallel line texture (wood

grain?).
