Title: Calumet Bag

Date: 1890 – 1910

Material: skin; glass

Dimensions: 14.0 x 74.0 (approx.) cm

Description: A long leather pouch with long leather fringe along the bottom edge. The opening is shaped and beaded around the edge. The bottom third of the bag is beaded with a light blue background and a diagonal design in red, and a blue with orange design at the top and bottom. Horizontal lines of beads (interrupted after every third bead) form the design on the back of pouch.

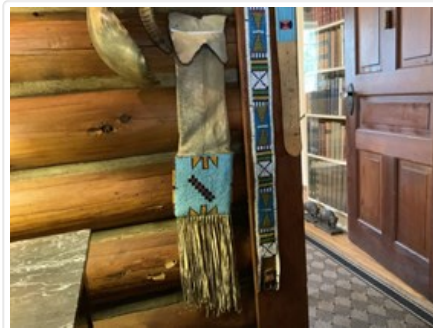
