Title: The Pack Horse

Date: 1931

Medium: Medusa cement [self-setting]

Dimensions: 36.0 x 46.0 cm

Description: Colour: white. This is a bas-relief of a pack horse facing right standing in grass. Modelled ca. 1931 for Tex Woods, a packer and guide in Banff, for gable on house on Spray Avenue. Taken off house in 1977 by Ray Haimila. He had permission to cast 14 bronzes plus 1 Aluminum on the condition that he present the master cast to the Peter and Catharine Whyte Foundation. He presented 1 bronze to the Senior Citizen's Home in Canmore; sold the others.
