Description: This horse is brown in colour and has a red horse blanket and light coloured pack on it's back. The horse has a light coloured nose and patch extending up between it's eyes. The horses legs are white with a small black section just before the colour turns to brown nearing the top portion of the all of the horses legs. The horse's tail is black. This is one of only two castings of this horse. The other belongs to E.S. Newbury, Lowell Road, Concord, Mass.
