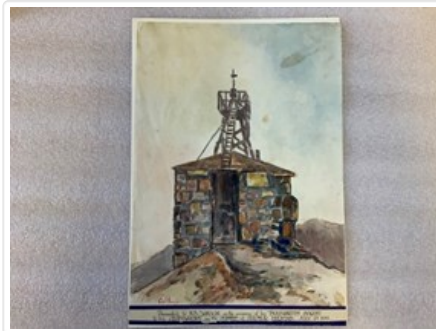


Watercolour Painting
