

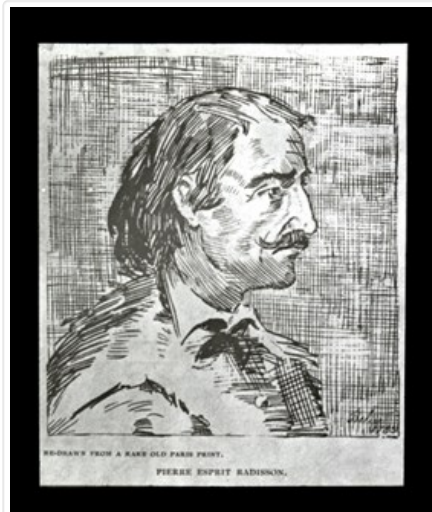


Pierre Esprit Radisson : re-drawn from a rare old Paris print - [portrait]

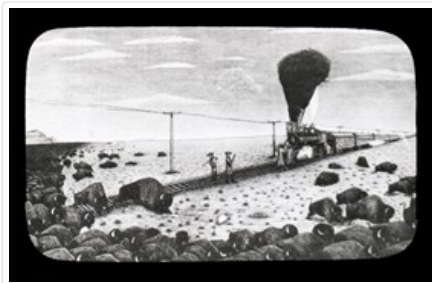

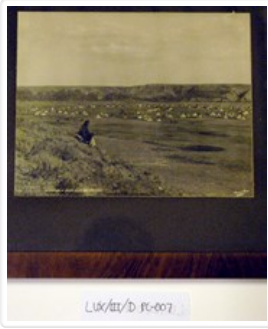

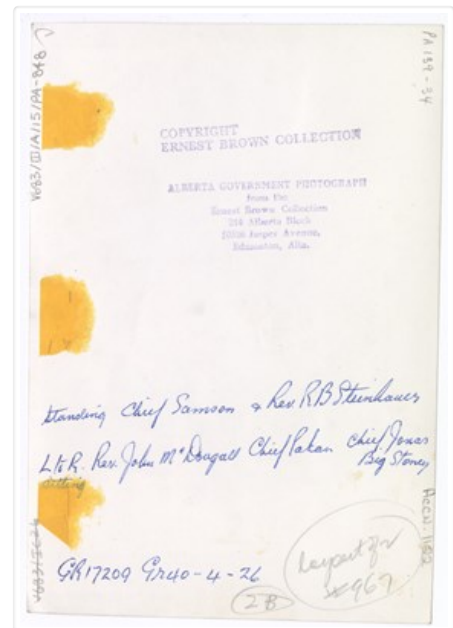
