Description:	One handmade pack horse model by Bert Riggall. Made of log section, nails, wood and cord. Initials "F.H.R." (Frederick Herbert Riggall) carved into side of sculpture. Base is bark covered piece of wood. Label by Bert's daughter Doris "Babe" Burton reads: "This 'animal' was used to teach new Packers to put on the vital Diamond Hitch."

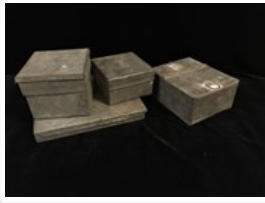
