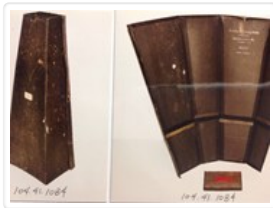

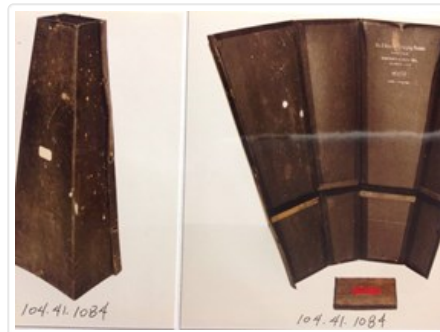

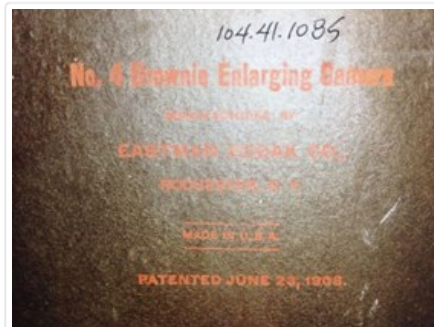


Daylight Enlarger

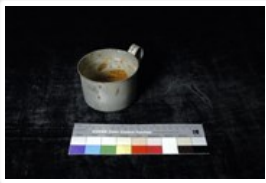

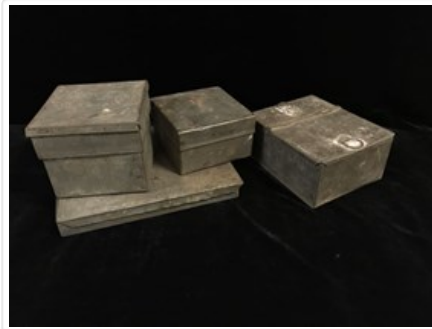
