Both have manufacturer's stamp on handle: "U.S. TUSA Co. 1917." a) is charred on the bottom with scratched in initials "E.F.T." and has typewritten label by Bert's daughter Doris Burton: "F.H.R.'s earliest camp dishes for 2 to 4 people. 1909 etc." b) has typewritten label: "One of a set of F.H.R.'s early plate-combinations. 1909 etc."

Description:	Bolt action rifle; one piece shaped wooden stock; teardrop-shaped rest on stock; crosshatching on stock and bolt handle; double trigger; no sights attached to rifle, though there are screw holes for the sights; two metal loops attached to underside of rifle for attachment of strap; rubber attached to butt end on stock; piece of wood missing from front end of stock on right hand side; Marks: no maker's marks on barrel or stock; no manufacturer's stamps; on rubber at butt end of stock: "HAWKINS PAT'D."; on the safety: "READY"; "SAFE"; near bolt (second safety?): "ON"; "OFF"
