Description:	Red and gold academic hood, red velvet border, 8cm. wide, fits over shoulders, main body hangs down back, lower edge is rounded. Outside is solid gold colour, inside is red with two gold bands, each 14 cm. wide. An arc is cut into center seam to create a deep pocket, 29.5 x 15.5 x 21cm. tag inside pocket reads "09595 year "74 code 63 for Univ. of Calgary Hr. Dr. Hd. Sainthill Levine". Hood is contained in a black nylon zippered pouch, 34 x 40cm.

Beaded Collar

Title:	Beaded Collar
Date:	1875 – 1925
Material:	glass; skin; fibre
Dimensions:	43.0 x 36.0 cm
Description:	<p>A heavily beaded yoke, edged with beaded loop lace, to be worn over the shoulders and hanging in front and back with a point at the middle. Completely covered with blue background beading and simple large stylized four-petalled flower in red with black at inner part of each petal around red centre, and four elongated green leaves, one between each petal. Long black stems curving off to each side hold three-pointed blossom of dark green and orange outlined in lighter green with two dark green leaves beneath. Same motif repeated on back but slight colour variations. Entire yoke edged with wide, looped netting of cylindrical beads forming lace like effect with strings of buckskin threaded with beads hanging from the outermost edge. Netting beads of transparent amber, green, turquoise, white, and red.</p>

Title:	Beaded Jacket
Date:	1935 – 1955
Material:	skin; glass; fibre
Dimensions:	57.0 x 63.0 cm
Description:	<p>A woman's tan buckskin jacket, fringed and lightly beaded with flowers, smoked buckskin, edges pinked. Cut western style with collar, yoke, inset sleeves, and pockets with front opening full length. 12.0 cm fringes below front yoke, and down backs of sleeves continuing across yoke in back. Front ties closed with four sets of buckskin thongs. Six large beaded flowers on two front pockets, front yoke and back are shades of blue with red and yellow accents, with yellow leaves outlined in green. Each side of front band contains four chevrons in shades of blue with red accents, pointing toward front opening. Machine stitched and completely lined with cream coloured fabric. Two inside breast pockets with stitching above to indicate that there may have been flaps there at one time.</p>

Description: A collection of four simple squarish cotton bibs worn in ski competition. Crudely hemmed, with twill tape straps and tie. Name of race and entrance number printed on. (a) "1976, logo, 2235 Sunlife" printed in red and blue. Unhemmed with neck strap and waist ties. (b) "1977 logo 3361 Sunlife", as (a). (c) "Veteran Ski Race Tita's Trophy 40 Banff, Alberta 1976" printed in red with number stenciled in black. Neck strap and waist ties. (d) "Mount Norquay 7 logo of stylized "M" sitting on bar " printed in blue. Double bib for front and back with straps connecting over shoulders and waist ties. Shoulder straps knotted to shorten.

Description:	Deep blue, glass, round bottomed bowl which sets into sterling, circular, three legged, straight sided stand which has band of decorative, open silverwork at rim under which rose and leaf patterned garlands festoon between the three legs.

Title:	Bowl
Date:	1900 – 1930
Material:	metal
Dimensions:	13.1 x 16.3 cm
Description:	Deep, belled sterling bowl, plain design which is set on separate ornate base which consists of oval sterling stand above which extend eight lily like supports for bowl. Hallmarks on base include "Georg Jenson" crowned circle, "sterling" stamp, "Ex", stamp, "C1 925" in circle stamp, "6" stamp and "Denmark" stamp. Hallmarks on bottom of bowl difficult to see but identical with exception of "302" replacing "6" mentioned on base. Bowl base also does not contain the "Rx" like stamp.
