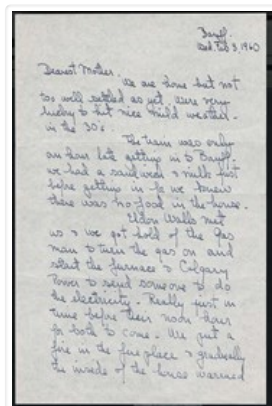

Letters are mostly hand-written, some typed. Also includes postcards and a notecard.

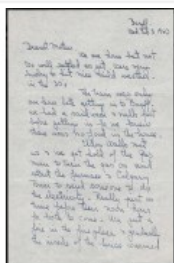

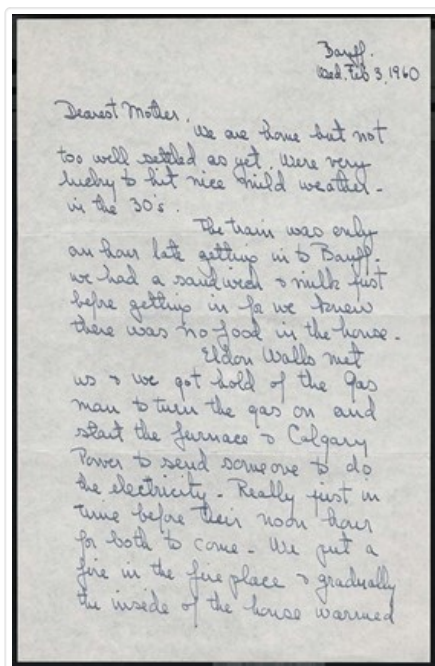

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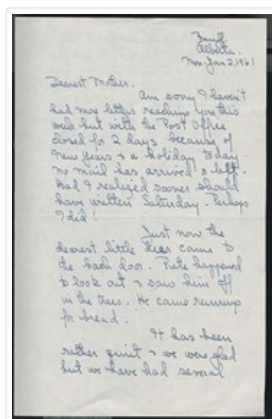

Topics include day to day life, Banff events, visits from friends, painting, wildlife, travel, hockey and football games, the Calgary Stampede, weather, and the 1962 space launch. Letters are mostly hand-written, some typed. Also includes postcards and notecards.

M36 / 148 - 114 to 120 are not fully dated - unsure of order within other 1961 letters. All are postcards.

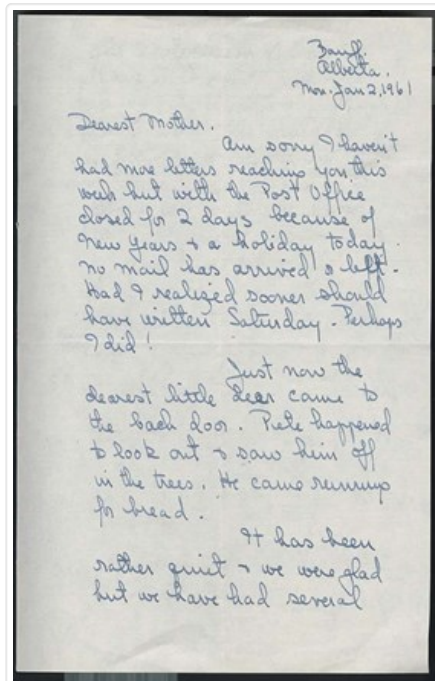


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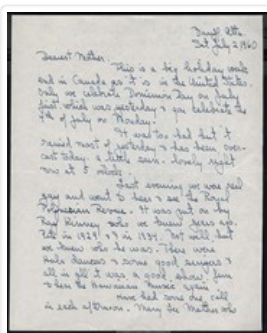

Letters are mostly hand-written, some typed. Also includes postcards, a telegram, and a notecard.

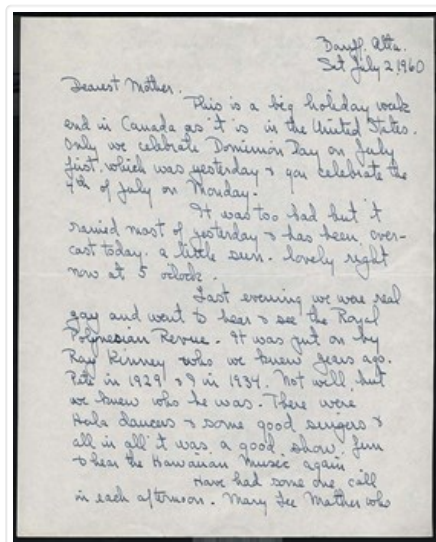

Title:	Musket Ball
Date:	1811
Material:	metal; glass; wood
Description:	Two musket balls matted and framed with inscription. Frame is 15.5x23.2, behind glass. Inscription reads "Musket Balls lost by David Thompson at Athabaska (sic) Pass on January 13th, 1811, and discovered by The Interprovincial Boundary Survey July 1921. Presented by R.W. Cautley The Leader of the Survey Party. Note In frame Musket was originally spelled Muske1 and then a bar put through to make it look like a t.
