Description:	Beaded purse with yellow zipper across top, one side, horizontal lines on light blue background and 3 stepped diamonds of small yellow squares outlining small red squares with green centres, 1 yellow cross with red centre beneath , other side 3 bands of yellow and blue beads in zigzag design, edge beaded by alternating lengths of transparent green and orange beads, unlined.

Title:	Candle Lantern
Date:	c. 1908
Material:	metal
Dimensions:	35.0 x 8.5 cm
Description:	<p>Metal folding lantern for candles. Thin clear fragile mica windows on three sides, (10 x 7cm). Front window damaged at bottom. Base with wire candle holder and 66 small ventilation holes. Also 8 adjustable holes on bottom left and right side. Lid has large ventilation hole protected by peaked roof on hinges. All seams are hinged so that lantern can collapse. Base folds flat up against back of lantern, sides collapse flat and fold to width of one side, lid folds flat and over sides to make compact (18 x 11 x 2 cm.) case. Stored in a thin unbleached cotton bag. Stamped on both sides of roof "THE 'STONEBRIDGE' FOLDING LANTERN PAT'D NOV. 20, 1906 JUNE 9, 1908 G.H. STONEBRIDGE M'F'G CO. N.Y.C. MADE IN U.S.A." A white candle is inside</p>

Dimensions: 18.0 x 11.5 x 31.0 cm

Description: (a,b) Pair of black leather hiking boots with 7 lace eyelets and hooks. Felt around opening. Tricuni nails on soles. Very heavy boots. Very well used. (c,d) Wood and metal adjustable shoe trees. (e,f) Brown leather hiking boots with 6 eyelets and hooks, hard rubber soles. Stamped on sole: "Innsbruck Bergsohle".

Title:	Ice Ax
Date:	prior to 1950
Material:	wood; metal; skin
Dimensions:	23.0 x 90.0 cm
Description:	Typical ice axe, wooden handle with small head. Stamped on side of pick end "Johann Hofer Fulpiales" and "Reg. Schutz marke". Steel collar and point 13.0 long other end. Leather strap is attached to a metal ring which floats on the wooden shaft. Leather keeper is nailed on to shaft near bottom. Inscribed on shaft near top is the letter "E".

Title:	Needlework Kit
Date:	1940 – 1950
Material:	fibre; metal
Dimensions:	10.5 x 29.0 cm
Description:	A flat rectangular cloth case for holding supplies with needlepoint cover worked in yarns of pink, purple and green with dark diamond shapes, border outlined with lighter pink and green. Light green rectangle in middle on one side reading "Mend It", other side "Darn It". Lined with pink slubbed purple fabric handstitched to form large pocket on lower half and strap across upper half. Pocket contains a (b) yellow cardboard "Needle Book" with picture of head superimposed over a maple leaf on both sides with assorted needles and threader inside. (c) Small paper book of Milwards needles.
