Title:	Beaded Jacket
Date:	1950 – 1951
Material:	skin; glass; fibre
Dimensions:	47.0 x 68.5 cm
Description:	<p>A woman's tan buckskin jacket, fringed and lightly beaded with flower accents. Cut western style with ruffled collar, yoke, inset sleeves, and two ruffled pockets in front. 12.0 cm fringes below front yoke, and down backs of sleeves continuing across yoke in back. Front is closed with seven buttons. Medium sized red, pink, purple, yellow beaded flowers on each front pocket. Front yoke and back beaded with white, yellow, blue, and green flower, leaf and stem accents. Machine stitched and top collar lined with tan coloured silk. A small tag labelled with red cursive stitching "Wonnacott" inside the lapel</p>

Title:	Beaded Bag
Date:	1920 – 1940
Material:	skin, moose
Dimensions:	10.0 x 35.0 cm
Description:	A rectangular flat bag of moosehide with a long moosehide fringe and a handle formed from two strips of moosehide tied together. The front of the bag is entirely beaded, with a background of turquoise patterned with red diagonal stripes in a row along each side and a column of red pyramids up the centre.

Title:	Beaded Bag
Date:	1890 – 1910
Material:	skin; glass
Dimensions:	52.0 x 18.0 cm
Description:	A rectangular, flat, bag with a long fringe of soft leather along the bottom edge and a short leather thong handle at the top. The bag is very colourfully beaded with a medium blue background and a many-coloured design (yellow, orange, red and many shades of blue). There are light blue bands along each side and a white band along the bottom. The bag has a pointed, beaded flap at the top that ties with a leather thong.

Description:	A long, narrow, curve bottomed flat bag with a rounded flap. The bag has a leather tassel hanging from the bottom edge. The front of the bag is completely beaded with a light blue background and a column of triangles of green, red, yellow and blue beads.

Title:	Beaded Bag
Date:	1890 – 1910
Material:	skin; fibre; glass
Dimensions:	12.5 x 32.0 cm
Description:	A flat rectangular purse with a long fringe along the bottom edge. The bag's opening fastens with a thong which ties through two holes. The front of the purse is defined with an outline of beads, the inside of which is filled with vertical rows of beads forming a horizontal design of three diamonds at the top and at the bottom.

Title:	Beaded Bag
Date:	1890 – 1910
Material:	skin, deer; glass
Dimensions:	9.0 x 9.5; 8.0 (fringe) cm
Description:	A curved bottom flat purse with a long deerskin fringe around the sides and bottom, and a handle made of two deerskin thongs tied together at the middle. Both sides of the purse are completely beaded with bands of red and blues which follow the contour of the purse's shape.

Title:	Beaded Bag
Date:	1940 – 1950
Material:	skin, deer; skin, muskrat; fibre
Dimensions:	15.0 (approximately) x 23.0 (approximately) cm
Description:	A deerskin pouch with a drawstring thong closing. The lower 2/3 of the pouch is covered with muskrat fur. The bag has a fringe along the upper edge of the fur and along the bottom edge of the pouch with longer fringe at the corners. There are beads edging the mouth of the pouch and along the top of the upper fringe. The bag is lined with a printed fabric.

Material:	skin; glass
Dimensions:	11.0 x 22.0 cm
Description:	A curved bottom flat pouch with a small 'tail' hanging from the bottom edge, and two short handles made of a string of beads. The pouch is entirely covered with beadwork of blue, yellow, dark blue and red beads with a cross of white beads on the front.
