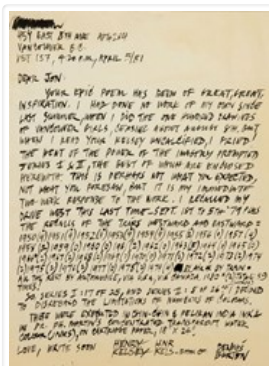

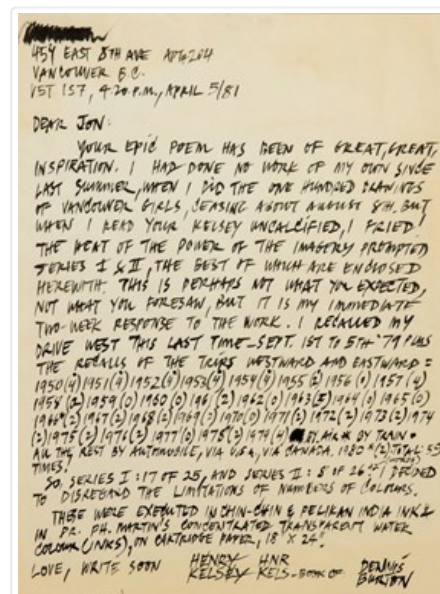
Description: Letter to Jon in black india ink. "454 EAST 8TH AVE APT 204 VANCOUVER BC V5T 1S7, 4:20PM, APRIL 5/81 DEAR JON: YOUR EPIC POEM HAS BEEN OF GREAT, GREAT INSPIRATION. I HAD DONE NO WORK OF MY OWN SINCE LAST SUMMER, WHEN I DID THE ONE HUNDRED DRAWINGS OF VANCOUVER GIRLS, CEASING ABOUT AUGUST 9TH. BUT WHEN I HEARD YOUR KELSEY UNCALCIFIED, I FRIED!
