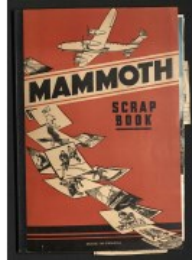

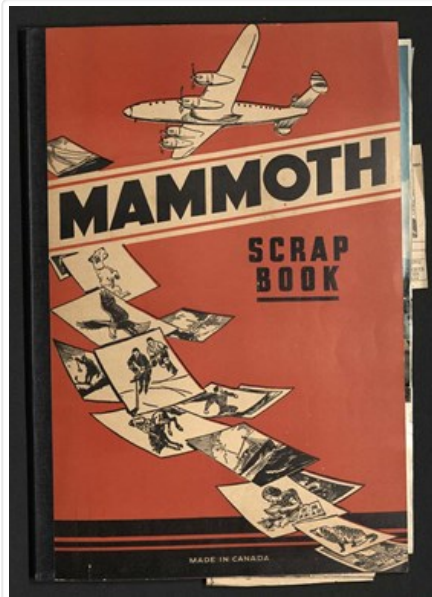

File includes: mortgage certificate executed by George E. and Ada Luxton to Grace S. Mariette; Canadian Passenger Association Press Certificate for G. E. Luxton; private correspondence, notifications, and invoices with R.J. Reynolds Tobacco Company, Imperial Bank of Canada, O.K. Electric, and Suburban Life Magazine; correspondence relating to the Lux Theatre regarding roof repair and seating replacement following fire loss with The Metallic Roofing Co. of Canada, Limited, and Winnipeg Scenic Co. Ltd; correspondence with Bausch & Lomb Optical Co. inquiring about Balopticon lantern projection; and seed orders and correspondence with Dingee & Conard Co., Briggs Seed Co., Limited, Hitchings & Company Greenhouses, and T. Eaton Co.

Notes: The Canadian Passenger Association Press Certificate ticket sheet booklet has one ticket sheet removed, all the rest are intact. Only one sheet of tickets is digitized.

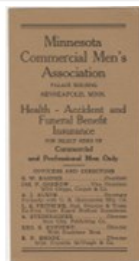

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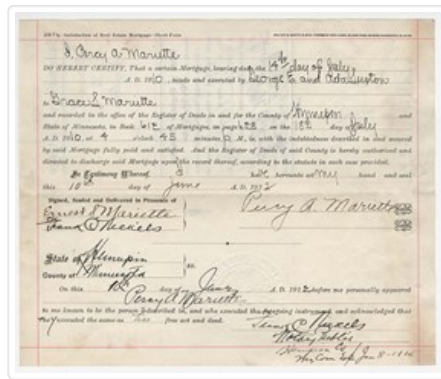


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CONTRACT

IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PRIVILEGES granted to me by the Transportation Companies which authorize the honoring of these certificates in their tariffs, I agree to the following conditions:—

4. That this Certificate will not be honored unless signed below by the person in whose favor issued.

5. That I will present this Certificate to Ticket Agent when purchasing ticket and with ticket to Conductor, Baggage-man or authorized Agent; and whenever requested by the Secretary of the Canadian Passenger Association, or any of the Transportation Companies or authorized Agents, Conductors or Baggage-men, I will produce this Certificate for their inspection or use.
