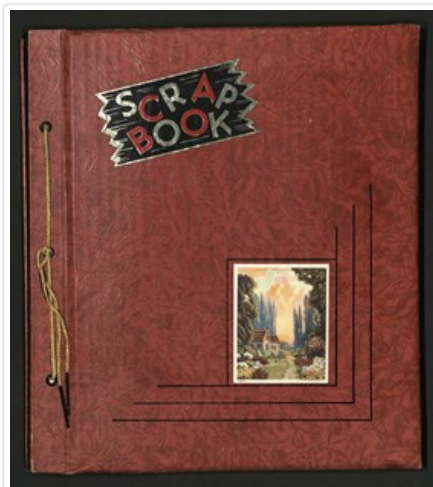

[Jack?] Munroe.
