

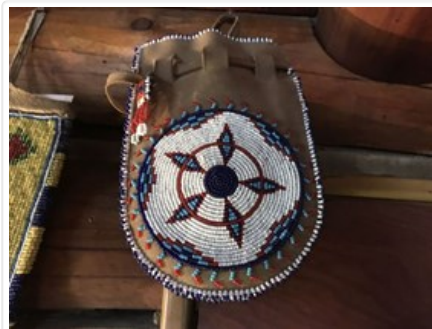


Beaded Bag

Title:	Beaded Bag
Date:	1920 – 1950
Material:	skin, deer
Dimensions:	11.0 x 16.5 cm
Description:	A small, rounded flat deerskin pouch with a thong at the neck used to close the pouch. The bag has a fringe of beads along all of its edges and is decorated in the centre with a large circle of beads with five diamond shapes around a smaller inner circle. There is also beadwork at the end of the fastening thong with three beaded loops.
