Title:	Balance Scale
Date:	1890 – 1920
Material:	bone, monkey; metal, brass; hair, horse; grass, bamboo; rattan
Dimensions:	a) .5 (pan x b) 6.6 x a) 32 (bea cm
Description:	A Chinese gold scale (a) and case (b). a) A scale with a long thin rod made from gibbon bone with a scale marked along its length with small dots. A brass pan is suspended by a black thread through a hole at the blunt end of the rod. There is a single thread at 9.5 cm from the blunt end that acts as a fulcrum to hang the rod. b) A violin-shaped case made of carved bamboo that is hinged with brass at the end of the stem. A braided rattan ring slides down the stem to secure it when closed. There are carved areas inside the case to fit the pan, rod and weight. The case is marked with a symbol carved into the outside. There is also a red and white paper inside with Chinese characters and "Ex.B Harry Sam" handwritten.

Description:	Rectangular, circular raised motto, 4.5 diameter raised motto, a crown in the centre "IN TRUE FEST" and a small wreath around outer circle. This circular piece is soldered onto main buckle, underside has a moveable circular bar with a one-piece 2 prong catch. A 2.0 long x .8 high loop at other end, 1.4 from end.

Description:	<p>A long narrow bag with fringe along the bottom edge and a drawstring closing and flap at the top. The bag is completely beaded with a white background and figures of two horses (one white, one dark) with four crosses beaded at the top. The top of the fringe is wrapped with quills, predominantly red with white and dark zig-zag pattern. The flap is beaded at the end with three hair tassels.</p>

Title:	Commemorative Medal
Date:	1911
Material:	metal
Description:	Medals commemorate the Coronation of King George V, June 22, 1911: (a) shield shaped (4.7 x 3.3), gold coloured, head and shoulders (head on) likeness of King George V and Queen Mary centered. Raised lettering encircles the couple: "Coronation Celebration King George V and Queen Mary" below that, "June 22nd 1911, reverse manufacturers stamp. (b) round (3.2 diameter) profiles facing left of King George V and Queen Mary. Raised lettering around him: "King George V Queen Mary", tiny numbers near him, reverse, crown, sword and branch centered. Around him: "in commemoration of the Coronation June 22nd 1911"; 2 rings center top are attached to a gold coloured fob.
