Material: fibre; hair, sheep

Dimensions: 2.0 (thickness) x 33.0 x 91.0 cm

Description: A pair of handwoven wool saddlebags for a donkey or burro. Each bag

has a white background with a red diamond pattern and tassels of wool at the lower corners. The bags are attached with red and white straps at the upper corners and have flaps which are edged with plaid fabric. There

are ties to close the flaps securely.
