Description:	A steel buttonhook with a round brass handle. The button hook is made from a button, a brass shell casing, and a long steel hook. The button is stamped with a military crest - a maple leaf in the centre of a circle with a crown above and the word 'CANADA'. The buttonhook is also marked with "Canada - Honi soit qui mal y pense."

Title:	Canteen
Date:	1800 – 1900
Material:	fruit, gourd; wood; fibre
Description:	A canteen made from a circular dried gourd that has a wooden neck screwed in to one side. There are also two twisted basket loops attached to opposite sides of the canteen used to hold a long green carrying strap. The gourd has lettering printed on one side that reads "Souvr...de Chamounix...Mont Blanc..Hote H.P. de Savoie". The lettering is around a French horn with a yellow lyre at its centre.
