Description: A pin and a patch from the Calgary Highlanders:a) A grey metal pin in the

shape of a large "X" with an ornate round border of maple leaves and thistles and a crown at the top. There is a silver beaver in the centre of the pin and a banner reading "Calgary Highlanders" underneath the beaver.
b) A square patch of green (khaki) wool with "Calgary Highlanders"

worked in black machine stitching.

#103.07.0060 c-g) of the pin. The reverse image of the impression can be seen on the back, and a hooked pin is soldered to the top of the

crown.
