square pan, with a dappled bottom plate - the tray has "OVENEX THE NEW BAKING METAL" and the patent number stamped in the top left corner. Platers and Stampers, Ltd. was a subsidiary business of EKCO, an American company that wanted to cash in on the British market - Platers and Stampers was the name given this off-shoot in order to make

it sound more domestic and less "American."
