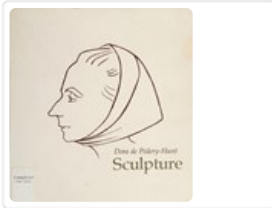

(c) "Memorium-Eorum Retinebimus/Legion", oval gold-coloured medal, 27mmx32mm long with a light brown ribbon.NOTE (a,b,c are on one pin) (d) dog tag '1251330/Sig. F.O. Brewster P/CDA", octagon shaped 39x34mm.
