Title: Beaded Moccasins

Date: 1913 – 1914

Material: hide; plastic; fabric

Dimensions: 5.0 x 6.0 cm

Description: A child's pair of slip on buckskin and fabric moccasins. The lower sections are dark brown hide while the upper is pink velour and the interior is pink fabric. The tops of the moccasins have blue, clear, and white beadwork. The blue and clear beads are arranged in a circular burst design with 4 smaller designs above and below. The white and clear beads are in groups of 4 and outline the tops of the moccasins.

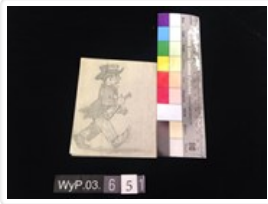

Date:	1917 – 1939
Medium:	graphite on paper
Dimensions:	12.1 x 9.9 cm
Description:	A handmade, unfinished card with a drawing of a haughtily-dressed man striding to the viewer's right. He wears a jacket with coattails, checkered pants, and a hat with a turned-up brim. He carries a walking stick and wears glasses. On verso (back of folded card) a pencil sketch of what appears to be a guide for the drawing on the front. Lines mirror the general shape of the drawing of the man. Inside the card, and oriented in the opposite direction from the drawing, is the following inscription in cursive: Dear Mark -I received your letter and I am glad to hear you are making those moccasins for me. I am away from Banff at present and I want yo to send [...]

Description: A man wearing a headdress (only upper and lower arm bands, a loin cloth, and moccasins) stands by a small fire with his arms crossed. There are trees off to the right of the figure, and in the background you the ink lines make out the outline of trees. Above the trees it is a night sky that has a very large moon taking up most of the skyline.
