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Beaded Moccasins

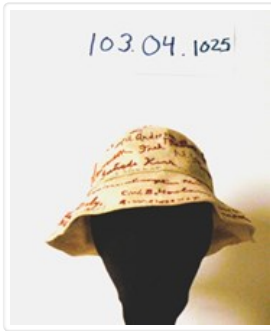

Title:	Beaded Moccasins
Date:	1940 – 1950
Material:	skin, deer; fibre, silk
Dimensions:	25.0 cm
Description:	A pair of soft moccasins shaped to the foot and sewn around the sole. Each moccasin has an ankle flap with leather thongs for tying. They are decorated with very simple three and four petalled flowers and leaves embroidered on the instep with pink, red and blue silk thread.

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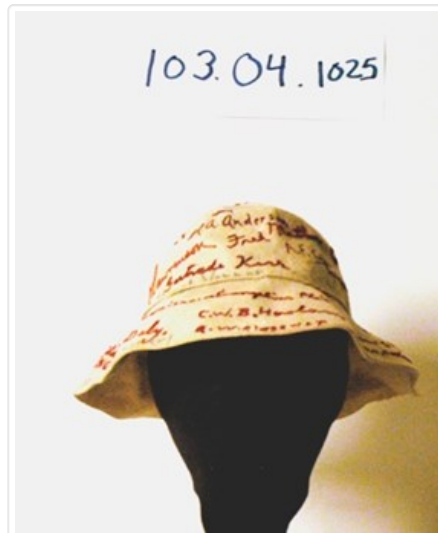

Title:	Needlework Kit

Material:	fibre; metal
Description:	<p>Small folding hard-sided sewing kit. The interior of the case is finished with fabric. The bottom half has indentations to hold the kit's components, but most of the pieces are now missing - there are only two needles and a pair of scissors left. The lid is padded and has many needles and pins inserted into the fabric.</p>

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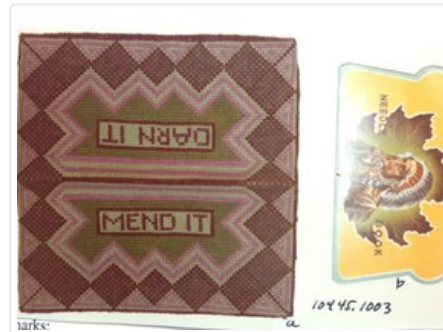

Title:	Needlework Kit
Date:	1940 – 1950
Material:	fibre; metal
Dimensions:	10.5 x 29.0 cm
Description:	A flat rectangular cloth case for holding supplies with needlepoint cover worked in yarns of pink, purple and green with dark diamond shapes, border outlined with lighter pink and green. Light green rectangle in middle on one side reading "Mend It", other side "Darn It". Lined with pink slubbed purple fabric handstitched to form large pocket on lower half and strap across upper half. Pocket contains a (b) yellow cardboard "Needle Book" with picture of head superimposed over a maple leaf on both sides with assorted needles and threader inside. (c) Small paper book of Milwards needles.

Title:	Place Mat

Material:	fibre, flax
Dimensions:	29.0 x 47.0 cm
Description:	A white rectangular grass linen place mat (probably for use on a tray) with blue stitching around the edge. The mat is embroidered with various colours about one quarter of the way down from the top. The embroidered design is a horizontal line with a pagoda at the centre and figures on each side of the pagoda. There is a figure of a coolie carrying a yoke with a basket and bag on the right hand side, and two figures carrying a closed carriage on the left.
