six hairpin lace work circles. All doilies are slightly yellowed and the hairpin work is starting to pull away from material on all pieces.

piece is handmade and monogrammed with an "M" (Moore). The centre

has square openwork design - Italian "punto tirato" technique.

Title: Doily

Date: 1900 - 1940 Material: fibre, cotton Dimensions: $26.0 \times 26.0 \text{ cm}$

Description: Two very delicate doilies, each entirely made of fine cotton thread using

the hairpin lace technique. The design radiates from the centre of each piece, ending in a sixteen point star shape. These doilies were possibly

made in Ireland.
