around the outside edge. The collar is wide at the back and tapers to rounded ends for tying at the front.b) Fine cotton collar with a stand-up neck band. The collar is embroidered around the bottom edge and

around the edge of the neck band.

covered bobbles on the front.

Title: Gauntlet Gloves

Date: 1930 – 1950

Material: skin; fibre

Description: 2 pairs embroidered gauntlets with fringes a,b: (38.0 x 22.5) machine

sewn construction, gauntlet lined with yellow cotton which also forms a 0.5 wide edging, on hand back embroidered pink and purple rose with green and yellow stem, on gauntlet embroidered 4-petal red and pink flower, green stems and leaves, dark blue flower in one corner, dark red in other, fringes ca 9.5, c,d: (36.0 x 19.0) machine sewn, gauntlet lined with unbleached cotton, on hand back embroidered star, light and dark red, 4 smaller designs, 2 light and dark red, other yellow and green, gauntlets, 1 light and dark red flower, green and yellow leaves, grey and white stems, fringes both sides ca 7.5.

Handknit Stocking

Title: Handknit Stocking

Date: prior to 1930

Material: fibre; metal

Dimensions: 13.5 x 36.5 cm

Description: One stocking in the making. Very fine knitting, needles are 1.0 mm thick.

Ribbed at the top, which would be below the knee, it narrows at the ankle, heel is turned, and the knitting stops half way to the toes, needles intact. (b) 52.0 long and 12.0 wide at opening, this is a long stocking shaped

tube of fine cotton, however there is no indication for a heel.

top.
