Material: fibre, cotton

Dimensions: 32.5 x 46.0 cm

Description: A black woven cotton bag of three bands of material sewn together, with the two outer bands extending to form the handle. The bag has a cotton lining. The bag is decorated with bands of red and white geometric flowers that border the handle and inside panel. There is also some pick-up stitch embroidery along the top opening of the bag on centre panel. The bag has four gold tassels hanging along the bottom edge.

Description:	A pouch-shaped crocheted cord bag with a long woven handle. The bag is decorated with a pattern of white diamonds connected with white horizontal bands surrounded by smaller black and red triangles on each side. The circular bottom of the bag is natural coloured with a red ring.

Date:	1950 – 1960
Material:	fibre, plant; fibre, raffia
Dimensions:	23.0 x 36.0 cm
Description:	A very loosely woven bag of straw with the straw warp only woven together in five rows. The bag has a braided edge at the top, and a braided handle that threads through the top row of straw. The bag is decorated with a red and green raffia design sewn on the front.

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Lace Loom

Title:	Lace Loom
Date:	1925 – 1950
Material:	wood; metal; fibre, flax
Dimensions:	8.0 x 17.5 x 30.0 cm
Description:	<p>A very crude home made lace loom. There is a flat board as a base with two square wooden pieces standing at each end, in the corners, with round dowel roller beams between them supported through holes at the centre of each side piece. The front has a narrow board nailed between the two square pieces, and the back has a wire mesh screen panel to act as the reed. An ecru linen thread warp is wound on a back roller, passes through holes in the screen, and is placed in tension (maintained by nails through rollers). The lace, woven with threaded needles, has been wound on a forward roller as it was completed. There are strips of elastic and cotton around the middle of the loom (to help with tension?).</p>

Title:	Place Mat
Date:	1900 – 1920
Material:	fibre, flax
Dimensions:	12.0 x 12.5 cm
Description:	A set of six, nearly square, white placemats of finely woven linen. Each mat has a square of cut and drawn openwork with a pattern of "X"s and "O"s in the centre that is surrounded by another band of cut and drawn openwork. The placemats have narrow hems.

Material:	hair, sheep
Dimensions:	18.5 x 14.5 cm
Description:	A flat, rectangular, bag of white and black wool with red vertical zig-zag bands. The bag has three beaded tassels hanging from the bottom edge, and two knitted multicoloured dolls hanging from the bag's long red handle.

Material:	hair, sheep
Dimensions:	15.0 x 19.5 cm
Description:	A rectangular, flat, red wool bag with pink, orange, yellow, green and white narrow stripes between three vertical red and white patterned bands. The purse has a green tassel at each of the bottom corners and a pink tassel at the middle of each side and the bottom.

Description:	A circular handbag formed from two woven disks of natural straw that have been sewn together along the outer edge with green and red raffia. The bag is decorated with groups of red, orange and purple flowers with green leaves, each group spaced evenly around the bag. The bag has a single braided straw handle.
